

### BANANA SPLIT SALAD

### First layer:

2 c. graham cracker crumbs

1 stick margarine, melted

Press into the bottom of a 9x13 pan.

### Second layer:

2 c. powdered sugar

2 sticks margarine

2 eggs

1 tsp. vanilla

Beat 20 min. with electric mixer.

Spread in pan.

### Third layer:

7 bananas, cut up

Place evenly over pan.

### Fourth layer:

1-16oz. can crushed pineapple, drained

### Fifth layer:

9 oz. carton Cool Whip OR 2 pkg. prepared Dream Whip

Cover and refrigerate 8 hours.
